 Internet Service Concerns

At our most recent Board Meeting, a representative from **Unity** (formerly Kinetic/Windstream) introduced himself and discussed efforts to bring fiber internet service to the Community Center. Several residents shared concerns about service reliability and frequent outages. Following the meeting, the representative informed us that they are not seeing a significant number of outage reports in their system. To help identify and resolve issues, he strongly encourages residents experiencing service interruptions to submit reports directly to Unity whenever outages occur. If you have already reported ongoing issues and continue to experience problems, please reach out to me and I will help connect you with our local representative.
