Street Clearance Reminder

As a friendly reminder, please check trees and branches on your property that may be hanging over the roadway. To help keep our streets safe and accessible, branches should be trimmed to maintain **14 feet of clearance above the street**.
This allows road crews, emergency vehicles, and other large equipment to safely travel through our community.
